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Tori Be is an Atlanta-based vocalist, songwriter, and live performer known for her powerful voice, emotional storytelling, and commanding stage presence. Originally from South Carolina, she began singing at just two years old, developing her voice in churches across the state and building the soulful foundation that continues to shape her sound today. Her early appearances on her great-grandmother's radio program on WPJM in Greer, South Carolina deepened her connection with music, broadcasting, and live audiences. During this time, she opened for renowned gospel artists including Kirk Franklin, Shirley Caesar, Dottie Peoples, Slim & The Supreme Angels, and Luther Barnes Jr.

Now marking 11 years in Atlanta's live music arena, Tori Be has become a consistent presence across the city's venue circuit. She currently holds a residency at Acere Lounge and is a regular performer at St. James Live, delivering performances that blend soulful vocals, live-band energy, and authentic crowd connection.

Her newest performance credits include Downtown Sounds, a live concert series produced by the Georgia World Congress Center Authority (GWCCA) and held at Atlanta's renowned Centennial Olympic Park, and ATL Live 2, a live production created and produced by Joey Oscar.

Additional career credits include singing background vocals for the band Brick and for Joe Gable, and opening for T-Pain at Albany State University's 2016 Homecoming.

Tori is the founder and lead vocalist of the live band Press Play, a performance group recognized for dynamic shows and engaging musical experiences. Throughout her career, she has performed for audiences totaling more than 20,000 people and has shared stages with Starship and Grammy Award-winning artist CeeLo Green.

Her performance background also includes A Soulful Christmas for four consecutive years, The Cotton Club, Red Hot Broadway, and Cindy, as well as portraying Tina Turner in the Ike & Tina Revue in New York. She has also performed for community events hosted by the City of Douglasville and the City of Stockbridge, further establishing her reputation as a versatile entertainer.

With roots in gospel, soul, and live-band performance, Tori Be continues to grow as both a vocalist and bandleader, bringing passion, authenticity, and unmistakable vocal power to every stage she steps on.
